

“Find it @ MSVU” - Libtube Script

“Find it at MSVU” helps you find out if the mount has the article you need either online or in print. The “Find it @ MSVU” option is available in Google Scholar, Single Search and most database results. “Find it @ MSVU” may also appear as a “check for full text”, or “find it” link.

- The following are examples of the steps you can take to get to what you’re looking for.
- Let’s use an article from Google Scholar as an example of what “Findit @ MSVU” provides. If a citation or abstracts looks promising but is not directly available in full-text, click on the “Find it @ MSVU” link underneath your record to view its availability.
- Here, we can see that both the EBSCO and Jstor electronic databases have the article we are looking for available, click on either of these article links to be redirected to the article. –note that, After clicking on the article link, you may have to click on a PDF or html link to view your article. You can also click the “go to journal” link to browse the selected journal.
- Your journal may also be available in Novanet - you can tell by whether the Novanet catalogue link is present on your “Find it @ MSVU” page. If it is, this means that a print copy of the journal you need is in the library. Print journals are located on the main floor of the Mount Library, and are arranged in alphabetical order by title. Before hitting that stacks, take note of the dates available of the journal - make sure the article you need is within these parameters. Once ready, take note of the journal volume and issue number that you will need, and in some rare cases, of the call number.
- Sometimes, neither of these options is available – as you can see here, the Article link, or Novanet database link are not displayed. If this is the case, you can have your article delivered using the Document delivery option. Document Delivery is a service that allows faculty and students to order materials that are not available in the Novanet system. A link to the online document delivery form is made available here – when prompted, simply enter your barcode (which is located on your Mount ID) and password (which is usually the last 4 digits of your phone number.)
- If you have any further difficulties login in you can contact the library at library@msvu.ca.
- Once you have entered this information and clicked submit, Fill in your preferred delivery method. Keep in mind an article ordered through Document Delivery can take from 3 days if the article is held by another maritime university, or 8-10 days to be delivered if held elsewhere in the country.
- Finally, “Find it @ MSVU” also lets you the save your current article citation in Refworks.
